Should the government double the number of priority seats in Hong Kong?

Recently, there has been a heated debate about the government policy of priority seats. The government has proposed doubling the number of priority seats to provide some help to the passengers in need. They can easily access to the exit. Therefore, the government need to provide more priority seats to make sure that the needy will not be left standing.

Second, doubling the number of priority seats can promote the virtue of sacrifice. It can encourage people to provide more assistance to the needy and teach the younger generation a moral. It can also raise the awareness of caring the others to foster a harmonious society.

Third, doubling the number of priority seats can show our empathy. This policy is for people who are in need.
